

TRACY ARM

Tracy Arm fjord is located in the Inside Passage approximately 45 miles south of Juneau. Cruise ships wind their way through the fjord which is located in the Tongass National Forest. The surrounding mountains are approximately 7,000 feet high and numerous waterfalls, created by melting snowcaps, can be seen along the route. The twin Sawyer Glaciers, North Sawyer and South Sawyer, are located at the end of Tracy Arm. Wildlife is abundant and native animals include but are not limited to whales, sea lions, bald eagles, black bears, and mountain goats. Due to the microscopic sediment or glacial flour, the water is a glacial blue.



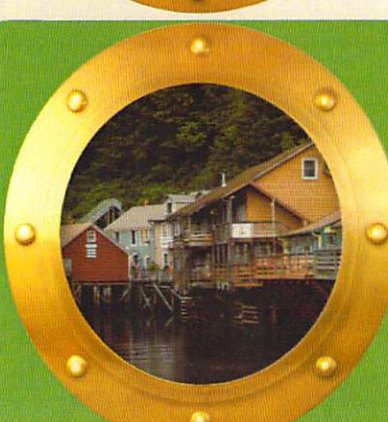
SKAGWAY

Skagway is located at the northernmost point on the Inside Passage in Southeast Alaska. Directly behind the town are majestic peaks of the Coast Mountains. The area around present-day Skagway was once inhabited by Tlingit Indians. "Skagua" was the Tlingit name and means "the place where the north wind blows". Today, Skagway still retains the feel of those Gold Rush days. The historic downtown has largely been restored to its roots, complete with false-fronted buildings and wooden sidewalks. Many of the local residents appear in their shops with turn-of-the-century costumes. The city primarily relies on tourism with over 700,000 tourists visiting the city each year.



JUNEAU

Originally, Juneau was a fishing outpost for local Tlingit Indians until gold was discovered by Chief Kowee of the Auk Tlingit Tribe in a creek off the Gastineau Channel. The Chief provided gold ore samples to George Pilz in return for blankets and work for his tribe and agreed to lead prospectors Richard Harris and Joseph Juneau to the find. The City of Juneau is located on the Inside Passage of Southern Alaska's panhandle and is located in a rain forest. Downtown Juneau is nestled at the base of Mount Juneau that soars almost 4,000 ft. The largest capital in the United States (*by land size*), Juneau is 3,248 square miles. Alaska is the only state whose capital city is accessible only via ship or air. No roads connect Juneau to the rest of the state.



KETCHIKAN

Ketchikan was originally established as a fishing camp back in 1883, when a salmon saltery was built by a man named Snow. The city became an important mining supply center following the discovery of gold and copper in the region. To support the growth of the city, the logging industry began to flourish. Ketchikan Spruce Mills started operation in 1903 and the city became the hub for logging activities and supplies. The mill operated for over 70 years. Today, the economy is based on tourism and fishing and the city is known as the 'Salmon Capital of the World'. Ketchikan is located in Southeast Alaska on Revillagigedo Island along the Tongass Narrows, at the foot of 3,000-foot Deer Mountain. Ketchikan is only accessible by boat or plane.

For the safety of all guests, outdoor events may be changed to inside locations due to unforeseen weather conditions.

•KEY TO THE WORLD

For your account security, please sign the back of your onboard identification card. If you would like to restrict your child's privileges, please notify Guest Services.

•NO RESERVED SEATS POLICY

As a courtesy to all guests we kindly advise that the saving of seats is not permitted in the Walt Disney Theatre and on the open decks.

•POOL SAFETY

There are no lifeguards on duty at any of the pools. For the courtesy of all Guests, reserving sun loungers on Decks 9 and 10 is not permitted. For the health and safety of our Guests, parents must observe the U.S. Public Health Service requirements by allowing only children who are toilet trained to enter shipboard pools and spas. Children who are not toilet trained may use the splash zone area located near Mickey's Pool port side, swim diapers are required.

•PRESERVING QUIET

Disney Cruise Line recognizes the importance of quiet and solitude to preserve wilderness values and marine ecology, and will minimize vessel announcements, Funnel Vision audio and music on the open deck while we are in our ports of call and sailing thru Tracy Arm.

•SECURITY NOTICE

For the safety and security of all Guests when we visit ports of call, all individuals (including children) must have their Key to the World and adults must present a photo ID before leaving the ship. You must be 18 years of age or older to go ashore unaccompanied. Guests under the age of 18 may go ashore unaccompanied only by having a consenting parent, guardian or other responsible adult with them at the gangway to provide their signature as authorization, which will be good for the duration of that port day.

•SMOKING

For the comfort of our guests the following areas are designated as Smoking areas: Open decks on the Starboard side (excluding Mickey Pool area).
